Autorefractor station with Jim Sims. We took the 3,840 prescription glasses with us in duffle bags on the ferry to Roatan. You can see the inventory behind the table on the stage. Each tray of glasses has 80 glasses each. We saw 270 patients that week, dispensed 93 prescription glasses and gave out 143 readers. There were a number of rededications in Evangelism and several saved.
