

Eyeglass Rack Assembly Instructions

update for Nicaragua

The Eyeglasses used in Honduras is almost identical to the one used in Nicaragua with these exceptions. Go to the main manual for detailed information.

- 1) The shelves on the Honduras unit are 24 inches by 48 inches while on the Nicaragua unit they are 24 inches by 36 inches.
- 2) There are 7 shelves on the each rack of the Honduras unit while there are 8 shelves on each rack of the Nicaragua unit.

Because of the similarity of the units the assembly document for these racks have not been updated. Below are several picture of the Nicaragua unit which might be helpful in the assembly process.

<p>Levelers at pole bottoms</p>  <p>Lay out poles with tape markers already applied.</p>	<p>Place black clips on top of poles</p>  <p>Also place black clips on bottom of poles with triangle pointing up</p> <p>Position top shelf near top of the poles.</p>	 <p>Affix top and bottom shelves to the poles.</p>	 <p>Stand rack upright.</p>
 <p>Put clips on poles at tape markers.</p>	 <p>Angle each shelf to attach to the clips.</p>	 <p>Add a shelf</p>	 <p>a second shelf</p>
 <p>a third shelf</p>	 <p>a fourth shelf</p>	 <p>a fifth shelf</p>	 <p>and the last shelf.</p>
