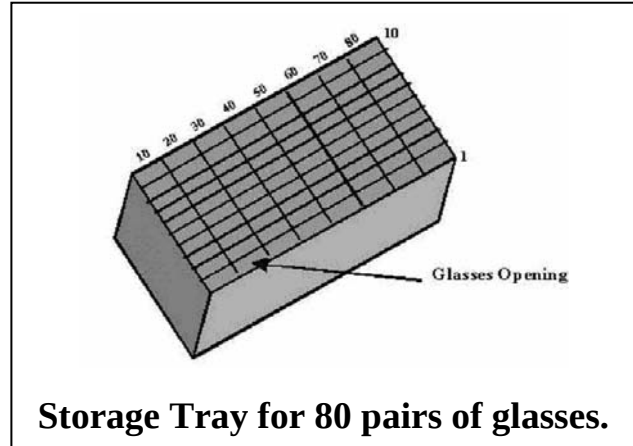


Eyeglasses Inventory Storage Box

The Eyeglasses Storage box (shown below) was developed to shorten the time required to find a pair of glasses in an optical clinic. When you shorten this time, you can help more patients. When used with the Eyeglasses Inventory program, the glasses fitters are given a list of glasses as shown to the right:

The fitter will then go to the storage rack (below left) and pull out the tray (middle). Since the front of the tray and each opening in the box dividers are numbered, the pair of glasses is found quickly.



Outside Box Dimensions: 19 ¾"L x 13"W x 13"H. Outside Tray Dimensions: 19"L x 12" W x 5 ¾"H

Depicted below are several views of the Eyeglasses Inventory Storage Box. The box has three components: 1) A protective box for transit (available in single or double thickness cardboard), 2) two inside trays, and 3) dividers within each tray for 80 pairs of glasses. Each box; therefore, holds 160 pairs of glasses. 50 boxes can hold 8000 pairs of glasses.

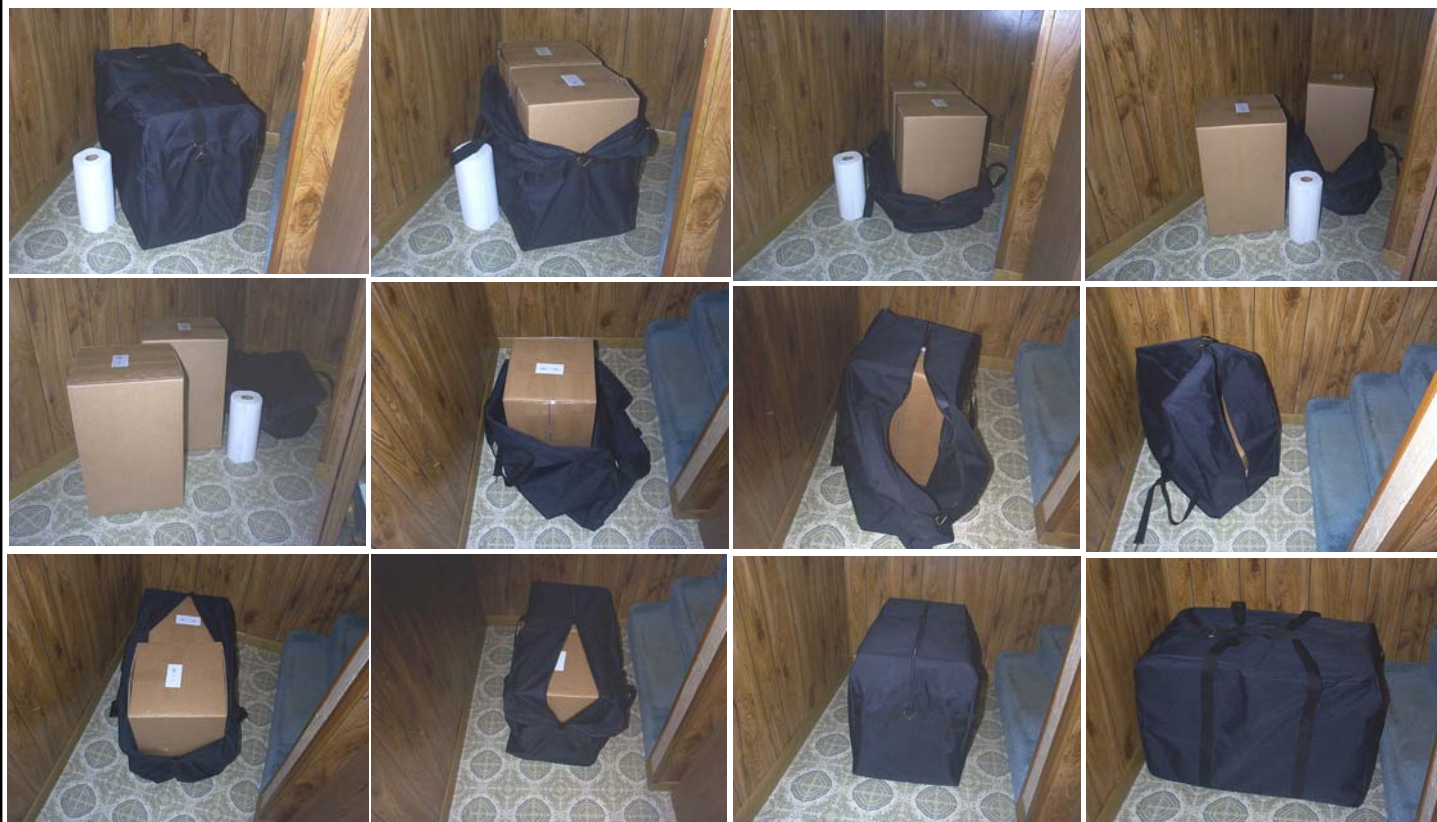

Storage Box Travel Bag

It is sometimes important that the eyeglasses storage box shown on the other side be carried on international flights. Due to airport security requirements, these storage boxes might be inspected. It is also important for them to be protected against moisture and physical damage. Using the Storage Box Travel Bag, the boxes may be safely shipped without having to tape them down. This would avoid damage by inspectors who may cut the box to get it open for inspection. To the right is a picture of the Storage Box Travel Bag. Below the bag is shown in several stages of removing the boxes.

The above pictures show the duffle bag open and the boxes being removed. They are then inserted one at a time. The first box is inserted and is then pushed back into the bag. The second bag is then inserted and the bag zipped closed. A 200 lb adult man can stand on these boxes when they are in this bag. The bag is heavy gauge durable fabric, large size nylon self repairing zippers, 2" webbing for extra stability, water resistant, comfort grip carrying handle, and over the shoulder strap and folds flat for easy storage. A video demonstrating the packing process is available. The bag overall linear dimension is 59.5" and weighs between 39 and 41 lbs when holding two boxes loaded with eyeglasses.

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
